

Silverwater Terminal

Silverwater Terminal is located in the western suburbs of Sydney, approximately 18 kilometres from the city centre. Located on a 4.5 hectare site the terminal stores and distributes petrol and diesel for the Sydney metropolitan and regional New South Wales areas.

History and Investments

- Silverwater Terminal was built in 1979 and has been modernised over subsequent years
- The terminal is supplied via a multiproduct pipeline connected to the Caltex Kurnell facility and can also be used to import products via the Vopak Botany Terminal
- Significant investment has been made in recent years to enable supply of biofuels, most recently including the introduction of biodiesel storage and injection facilities in February 2012

Terminal Overview

- The terminal has six bottom loading bays for the various Diesel and Petrol grades, including E10 and B5
- The terminal has eight tanks in service with a combined overall capacity of approximately 48 million litres
- The terminal also provides product additising capability

Operating Details

- Open 24 hours per day, 7 days a week, 365 days per year
- Manned operation: 24 hours per day; including public holidays

Facilities

- Driver facilities include:
 - Rest room, showers and tea room
